Taking It Home

Read 2 Kings 2:1-15. Why did Elijah want them to stay behind? Why do you think Elisha wouldn't leave his side?

What's the significance of Elijah parting the waters? What about Elijah doing the same thing?

Why do you think Elisha asked for a "double-share" of Elijah's spirit? How have you asked God to fill you and better equip you for the life's challenges?

In verse 14, people asked "Where is the God of Elijah?" after he was gone. If people were to ask of your life, "Where is the God of [insert your name]?" what would be the evidence and the answer?
